The Visual and Media Arts Department is looking for middle school students interested in Creating Art! This may include a passion in drawing using graphite, charcoal, pastel, pen and ink, paint, clay, plaster, digital art, video, or photography.

To apply to the SDSCPA Middle School Visual & Media Art Department:

Please come prepared to draw, and bring along a portfolio with 4 -5 pieces of artwork you have done that best show us your passion for art!

1. You may be asked to introduce yourself. Include:

1. Your first and last name
2. The grade you will be entering in the Fall
3. If you prefer to draw, do digital design, video production or photography

2. You may be asked some of the following questions:

1. Why are you interested in attending SDSCPA?
2. Why do you want to be a Visual & Media Art Major?
3. What do you love about creating Art?

3. Show us some samples of your artwork!

Bring 4-5 of your best works that you think will help us see the artist you really are

4. In-Person Activity

You will complete an in-person observational drawing activity, or still life, of any 1 object. You will be given a plain, white 8.5"x11" piece of paper and may only use a pencil. Your drawing should include your best efforts in line quality and value (dark, medium and light values to show volume of objects) and should be done on plain, white 8.5"x11" paper. You may use an eraser throughout the process and should complete your work within a 10-30 minute period.

All SDSCPA Auditions are closed.

Parents/Guardians are not able to view the audition or accompany their student to the audition room.

Students will be evaluated individually. Areas of assessment will include:

- Creativity
- Passion
